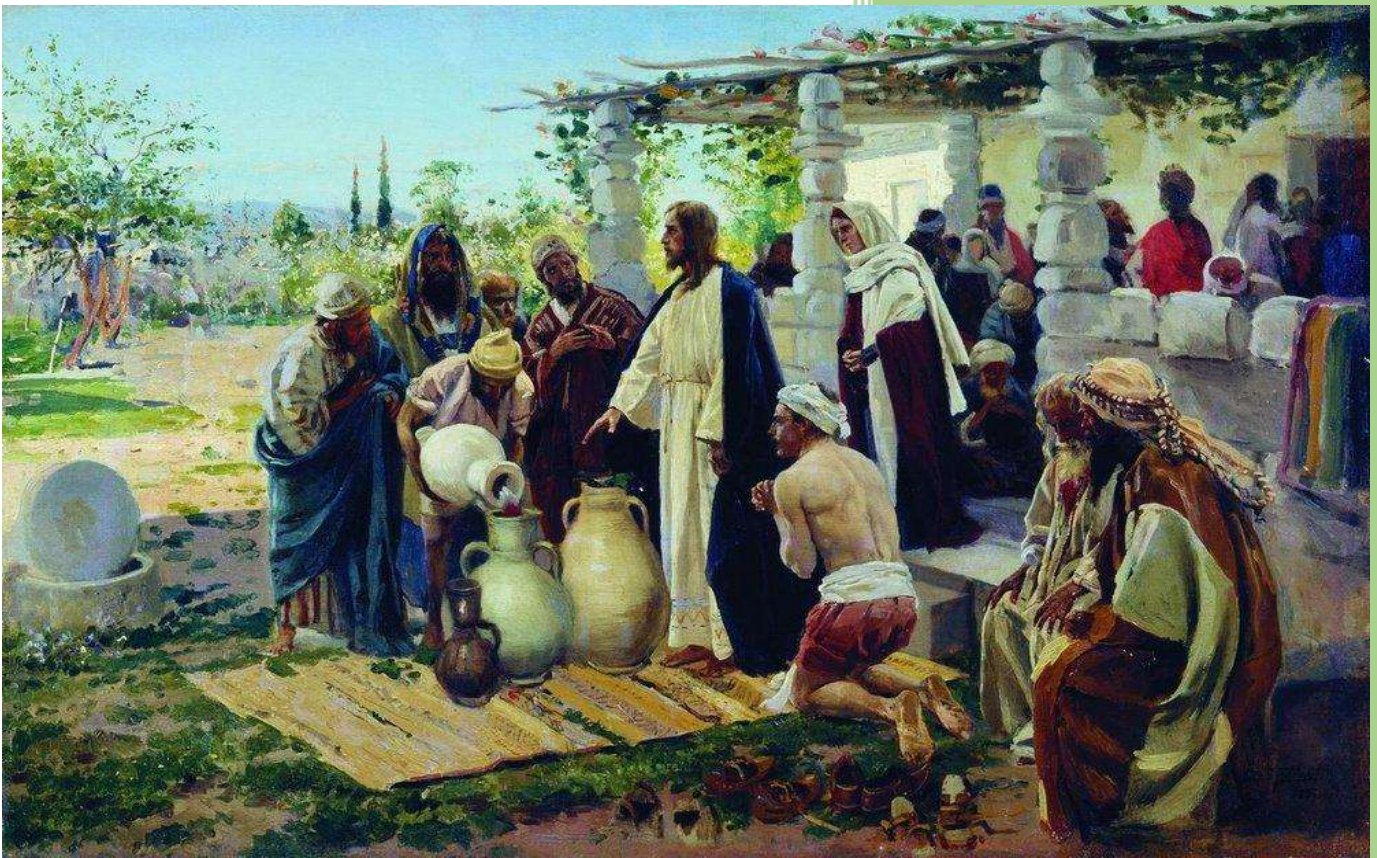

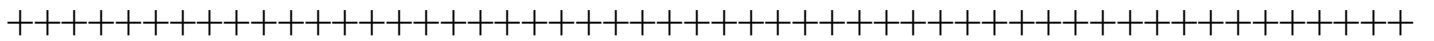

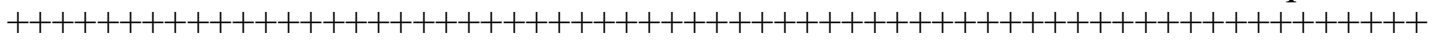
Women's Book Club will meet February 1, 10:00 a.m. in the Fireside Room. *The Hiding Place* by Corrie Ten Boom.
